Rules for Submission to Journal of Japan Society of Energy and Resources

*Except for manuscripts directly solicited by the editorial committee

1. Qualification for Contribution

The main author of all submitted manuscripts should be a member (regular member, special member, or student member) of Japan Society of Energy and Resources (JSER), and be the first author.

2. Submitted Manuscript

- (1) Submitted manuscripts should be useful for the mutual enlightenment of members and for industrial and educational development of Japan as well, through sharing academic or technological knowledge and experience.
- (2) The contents should be related to the field of energy, resources, environment, and associated fields.
- (3) Manuscripts should follow the rules of submission and the guidelines for authors, which are available from the homepage of JSER. Manuscripts which do not follow these guidelines may not be accepted.
- (4) Manuscripts should be submitted to the secretary office of JSER (toko@jser.gr.jp) by e-mail as an attached file in principle. Postal submission is also available.
- (5) Authors should also complete the designated "Author Information Card" and attach or enclose it when submitting manuscripts.
- (6) Authors should submit the copyright transfer statement which will be provided from the secretary office after the submission of the final version of the manuscript.

3. Category

Article categories are shown below. Only categories marked with an asterisk (*) are open for general submissions. For research papers and technical papers, an one-page abstract of the paper has been published in the print version of the magazine and the full paper has been published on the J-STAGE, an electronic journal platform for science and technology information in Japan, developed and managed by the Japan Science and Technology Agency (JST).

4. Publication fee

- (1) The publication fee for research papers and technical papers is charged as shown in subsidiary rule 1. An additional fee for paper offprints is charged if requested by the author.
- (2) The publication fee for all manuscripts except for research papers and technical papers is charged as shown in subsidiary rule2. The authors will receive a PDF file of the printed manuscript. An additional fee for paper offprints is charged if requested by the author.

5. Treatment of receipt and acceptance of manuscripts

- (1) All submitted manuscripts will be judged at the peer-review committee before being put to the editorial committee. Manuscripts which do not match with the rules for submission may not be received for review. The result of judgement and the date of receipt (the day that the manuscript arrives at the secretariat office) will be notified to the corresponding author.
- (2) The received manuscripts will be reviewed by the reviewers appointed by the peer-review committee. The acceptance of received manuscripts will be judged based on the report of the peer-review committee by the editorial committee (6 times a year, during even-numbered months in principle) and the results will be notified to the corresponding author. The date of acceptance is taken as the day when the editorial committee meeting is held. Category changes for papers may be requested.
- (3) The manuscripts will be recognized to be refused if the author does not respond to the inquiries of the editorial committee within the appointed period (3 months).
- (4) The receipt may be treated as "re-receipt" by the judgement of the editorial committee if the contents of the manuscripts are revised considerably.

6. Proofreading

The pre-print proofs will be sent to the author for proofreading. The author will have one opportunity to request edits to the proof, after which changes to the contents are not permitted. Re-assessment will be performed by the editorial committee if the contents are changed.

7. Copyright

The copyright of all contents published in Journal of Japan Society of Energy and Resources shall belong to Japan Society of Energy and Resources. Therefore, anyone who wants to reprint any contents from the Journal must ask for approval from the Japan Society of Energy and Resources. Copying in any form without notice is prohibited.

(Subsidiary rule 1)

The publication fee for research papers and technical papers is 6,000 yen per page.

(Subsidiary rule 2)

The publication fee for all other paper categories is 6,000 yen per printed page within the number of standard pages and 10,000 yen per printed page beyond that limit.
